Cyberpatriot

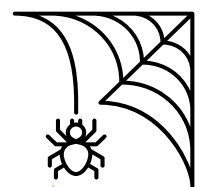

Complete your clearance to practice with these teams

To practice and compete with our teams, it is of the utmost importance that you are cleared to participate.

The process is as follows for both Color Guard and Drill:

- ✓ Click here to create an account on <https://athleticclearance.fhsaahome.org/>
- ✓ Get school insurance. The cost is \$30. If you have taken part in another sport or activity that requires a minimum insurance of \$30, you will not need to buy additional coverage. <https://schoolinsuranceofflorida.com/>
- ✓ You must complete the training videos for heat illness and sudden cardiac arrest. You will receive a certificate upon the completion of these videos. <https://www.hillsboroughschools.org/Page/5069>
- ✓ Upload your school insurance, certification of completion for the two required videos, proof of residence, birth certificate, and a government-issued ID of your parent or guardian into your athletic clearance account

What is Drill?

Drill comprises two teams: a regulation team and an exhibition team. The exhibition team works with a modified routine that involves complex marching sequences that usually deviate from standard drills, all while executing the spinning and throwing of drill rifles. The regulation team follows a more structured series of movements. The teams' ability to precisely execute these commands without error is evaluated.

What is Color Guard?

The Color Guard Team is responsible for formally presenting the United States and Florida State Flags during various events, all while showing respect to our nation's flag. A Color Guard team consists of 4 members: the National Flag bearer, the State Flag bearer, and the two guards that carry standard drill rifles.

Competitions for both teams will begin in January. However, we practice during the off-season to properly prepare for future competitions. Navigating these steps can be tricky.
