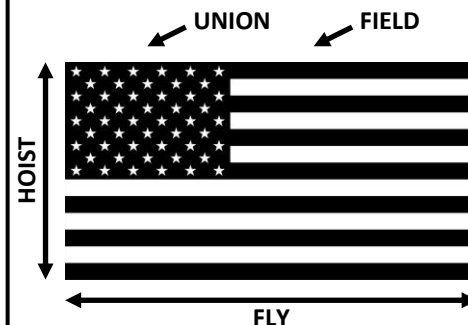
Seven Army Values

PARTS OF THE FLAG



OPEN RANKS:

- 1st Squad: 2 Steps Forward
- 2nd Squad: 1 Step Forward
- 3rd Squad: Stand Fast
- 4th Squad: 2 "15 inch" Steps Backward

CLOSE RANKS:

- 1st Squad: 4 "15 inch" Steps Backward
- 2nd Squad: 2 "15 inch" Steps Backward
- 3rd Squad: Stand Fast
- 4th Squad: 1 Step Forward
